


### 4580-2600 SPILL VALVE INSTRUCTIONS



Part 11 make up Part # 4580-2600 Spill (Unloader) Valve

Remove Spill Valve by grasping the knob at the top of the valve (# 11) with a <u>needle-nose vice grip</u> and pulling straight up. The Spill Valve is seated in the housing with a set of o-rings (shown but not numbered) so there will be a slight resistance.

When the valve is removed use a damp cloth to clean the valve and verify that there are no cuts, tears or damage to the o-rings. If possible clean and inspect the bore in the housing for pits or build up.

Next lubricate the top o-ring of the Spill Valve generously with silicone grease; **DO NOT LUBRICATE THE LOWER O-RING.** The lower o-ring holds the valve in place. The lubercation on the top o-ring allows the valve to open and close properly. Reinstall the valve and make sure that it is seated all the way to the bottom.

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
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

# K 620 M (1.973-680.0) PUMP BREAKDOWN




